In accordance with the operating policies of the Good Shepherd Foundation, grant income is to be distributed within the following four areas. Please check the area that most fits the purpose of the applicant:

 Grants for outreach into the community including institutions and agencies with which Good Shepherd relates, and to special programs designed for those in our community who are in spiritual and/or economic need.
 Grants to institutions and agencies of the South Carolina Synod of the ELCA and for missions of the ELCA at home and overseas.
 Grants to members of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church for the purpose of attending an ELCA Seminary, for church-related leadership conferences, or such other training which enables members of this congregation to grow in Christian faith and service to God's people.
 Grants for non-budgeted special projects of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church not normally funded by the congregation's annual budget.

ABOUT THE GOOD SHEPHERD LUTHERAN CHURCH FOUNDATION

The Foundation was organized in 2009 and is operated exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, specifically to support and benefit Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, the community, the ELCA, and other institutions and agencies as deemed appropriate. The Foundation is overseen by a Foundation Board which consists of five individuals who are active members of Good Shepherd.

Foundation funds are invested in the ELCA Mission Development Fund, which provides funding for missions as well as a fixed return for the Foundation and in the ELCA Foundation (a diversified portfolio designed for charitable giving).

Contributions to the fund may be made at any time and are an effective way to honor or memorialize a loved one or friend. For contributions of \$10,000 or more, the Foundation has provided specially-named memorial funds, which will be administered within the Foundation.
